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EVENTS AT WYLIE'S BATHS

Wylie's Baths is one of the most spectacular venues on the east coast - the perfect venue for wedding ceremonies and receptions, anniversaries, birthday parties, corporate functions, cocktail parties and charity nights.

Functions are held under both of the newly refurbished main marquee and northern marquee on the heritage listed deck overlooking the historic Baths, Coogee Beach and out to Wedding Cake Island.

Our event catering partners can work with you to decorate the marquee with theming, lighting and table arrangements.

In the event of extreme weather, clear oceanside panneling is available on both marquees to ensure your guests are comfortable, while enjoying the spectacular venue.



SMALL EVENTS

If you are wanting to hold a smaller function for up to 40 guests, we can host you in the Northern Marquee.

Small events are BYO food and drinks, Beer and Wine only (NO GLASS)

Bookings for Saturday nights can only be made 4 weeks prior.


The baths will remain open to our patrons during opening hours.



EVENT POLICY

Wylie's Baths can hold 120 people (seated) and up to 150 people (cocktail) maximum.

Small event venue hire is from 4pm - 10pm

All guests must be off site by 10pm for small events

Large event venue hire is from 6pm - 11pm

All guests must be off site by 11pm for large events

Noise management plan required to ensure minimal impact to our neighbours

No glassware permitted in any case (to mitigate hazard of breakages on pool-deck below)

Bar service must use polycarbonate in lieu of glassware

No open flames or smoking as the Baths is a heritage listed wooden structure

No confetti of any kind as to avoid any pollution

Security to be hired for all events



WYLIE'S BATHS HISTORY

Henry Alexander Wylie, a champion long distance, and underwater swimmer established Wylie's Baths in 1907. Henry's daughter Wilhelmina, along with Fanny Durack, were Australia's first two female Olympic swimming representatives. The first gold and silver swimming medals for a women's event in the history of the Olympics went to Durack and Wylie respectively. Wylie built the pool so that Mina could train to attend these 1912 Stockholm Olympics.

To begin work on the Baths, Wylie obtained a special lease below the high water mark. The construction of the Baths coincided with Sydney's emerging interest in seaside pools at the turn of the century.

The structure that frames the Baths is a strong part of Coogee's identity, and the structure is a prime example of pioneering vernacular architecture - a design solution based on indigenous techniques using unique framing to provide amenities on the steep cliff face.

Recent renovation of the Baths by Allen Jack and Cottier in 1995 won the RAI Greenway Medal for Conservation and was praised for its sensitivity in preserving the integrity and heritage of the original swimming complex.
